Dear Mr. Allison and Fellow Parliamentarians,

Thank-you for your interest and efforts to provide an opportunity for those injured by the COVID-19 vaccine to share their experience.

As you and your colleagues are preparing to listen to the testimony, I would ask that you consider the following themes which will undoubtedly emerge. Some of these have been mentioned over the course of the three (3) press conferences you have held. Additionally, some are related to the Rule 25 Exhibits listed on the inquiry website.

- I was not given informed consent with respect to the risks and benefits of the vaccine.
- Coercive tactics were used to increase vaccine uptake. I did not want to be vaccinated, however felt I had no choice: no jab, no job!
- Doctors are not trained to recognize vaccine injury.
- Doctors are not trained to treat vaccine injury.
- The medical community is not acknowledging that the condition\decline in health which I now experience is related to the COVID-19 vaccine.
- I was healthy, active, and enjoying my life prior to the vaccination event.
- Health care workers will not openly acknowledge my injury as being vaccine related out of fear of reprisal.
- Health Canada refers to relative efficacy and not absolute efficacy of vaccines.
- *"Safe and effective"* is a marketing slogan and not a statement of scientific evidence.
- Health Canada knew there would be people injured with the use of mRNA technology in humans and chose to declare the vaccines "safe and effective" regardless.
- There has been a concerted effort by Public Health to down-play vaccine injury so as not to create vaccine hesitancy.

- I have experienced gaslighting, told it's all in my head, or it's coincidental, or I must have had a predisposition to this condition.
- I am alone in finding the right help and getting any form of compensation.
- If I received compensation, it's pittance compared to the financial hardship I am experiencing.
- My quality of life has suffered immensely.
- It is now clear to me that vaccine uptake is more important to our government than those injured. I am considered acceptable collateral damage for the greater good.

Vaccine Choice Canada was born out of similar experiences of parents and caregivers with respect to the vaccine injury of a child. Parents were told the vaccines were necessary and required for school. The injuries range from mild, to sever, up to and including death.
